- **Incident management-** There are structured procedures for managing incidents and emerging issues and each school response is led by a **Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL)**.
- **Safeguarding Network** :The DSLs meet regularly as part of a safeguarding network.
- **Pastoral and wellbeing support** (and staff networks associated with these roles) within the school also play a critical role in ensuring a “wrap around” support to manage safeguarding issues that arise within the school community.
