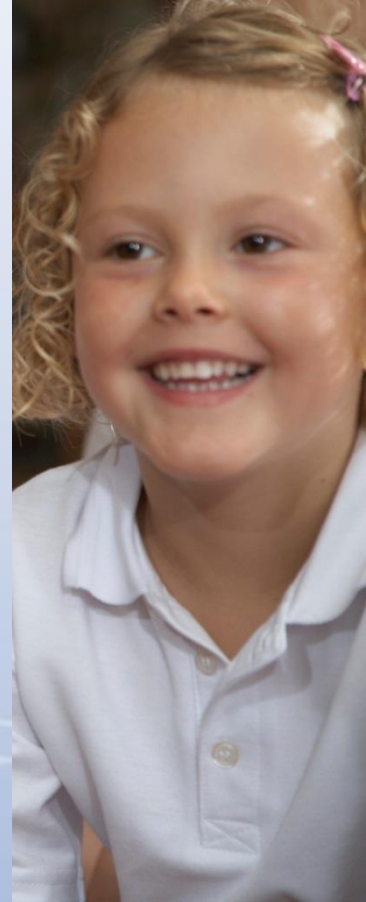
The Vision

- Identify and intervene as early as possible

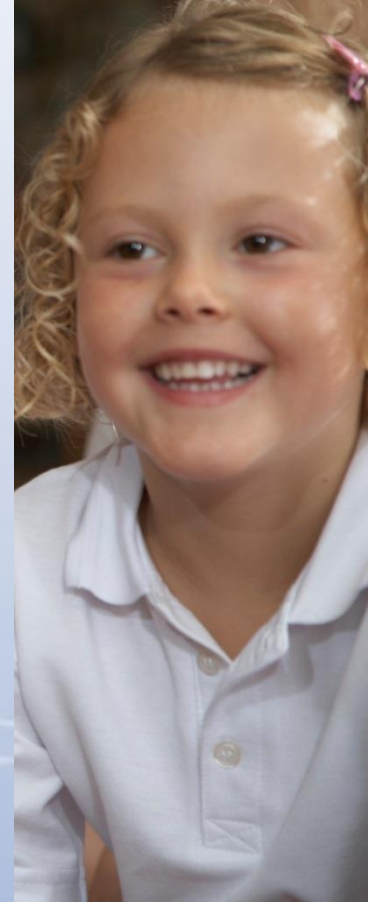
Building on good practice
