Reasons for referral

**Suicidal Ideation Habitual overnight online activity with people in various time-zones, often discussing depression and suicide. Sporadic bouts of exhaustion caused by the above, leading to low attendance and poor punctuality. Low mood, making him vulnerable to peer group friction and the development of some low-level bullying.**

Yesterday [REDACTED] some of [REDACTED] peers disclosed that he had written a post on the online forum, "discord" expressing that he's "going to kill himself" and that he therefore had "three months left". This is particularly concerning in light of the low mood that he has presented for much of this year, along with a historical reluctance to engage with CAMHS. [REDACTED] is now under CAMHS but there is a degree of scepticism and mistrust from the family with regard to the effectiveness and the objectives of this intervention: Following a preliminary assessment, [REDACTED] and Mum agreed that CAMHS would not be helpful, however were persuaded to give it another go. CAMHS nurse, [REDACTED] liaised with JCoSS to set up a meeting on the school site, with parents present. The professionals agreed that this was to discuss concerns over [REDACTED] online activity and
