- Provide support and advice to maximise opportunities for Barnet through the Government's agenda for school sport and competition



Year 2, Term 1: (all figures are based on sept – dec 2011 and 2012)

Competition:

- **Retained school buy in on the whole:** lost 3 infant schools, lost 2 junior schools and 1 secondary school BUT gained 2 special schools and 1 college
- **Increased the number of competitions** by 10 and school teams entering by 47
- **Increased number of Young People Participating** in competition by 195
- **Increased number of courses for teachers** by 2



Year 2, Term 1:

Leadership and Training:

- **21** more Young People trained via the Leadership Academy
- **2** more additional courses for leaders with **111** more young people attending
- Maintained our level of Young Ambassadors



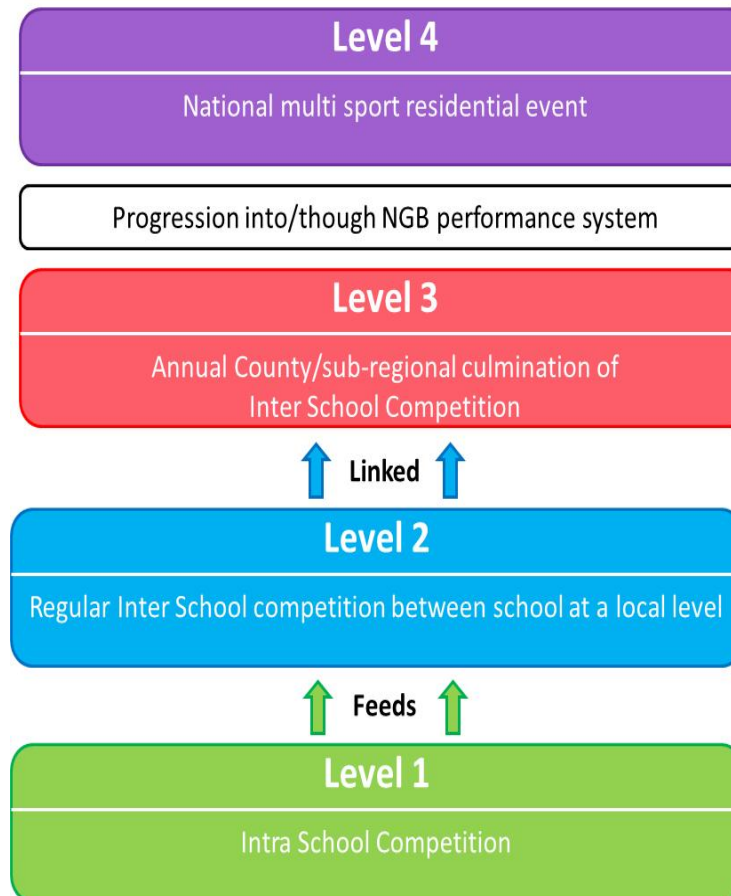
Year 2, Term 1:

New for this term (based on feedback provided last year)

- **Introduction of new basketball league for secondary girls:** 17 schools entering teams across 3 age groups in 2 new leagues
- **Introduction of secondary girls football league:** 11 schools entering teams across 3 age groups
- **Introduction of Barnet Healthy Family Programme:** based at 2 sites across Barnet: working in partnership with Middlesex University, providing a 10 week family engagement programme to encourage families to work together to become fitter and healthier
- **Introduction of more virtual challenges** (help to overcome transport issues)
- **Bikeability:** secondary school pupils taking up level 3 in bikeability.
- **More targeted work to engage non active participants:** less traditional sports offered as alternative activities such as ballroom dancing, cheerleading, handball and softball for secondary schools
- **Build on the Key Stage 1 programme:** working in partnership with All for Sport to deliver a 6 week KS1 programme using the Bupa Start to Move training for all KS1 teachers. 8 schools have started the programme, with a further 18 schools booked in for the remainder of the academic year
- **Develop the Inclusion Programme:** Research has been carried out to establish where disabled participants are in mainstream schools. Inclusive training for primary subject leaders and young leaders has been delivered to aid inclusive PSS Dates for the Diary: Jan – Feb ½ term
- **Barnet Strategic Sport Group** – lead by BPSS, bringing together key partners to improve provision of sport in Barnet (replace previous PESSYP group)
