




- Improvement in 5+ GCSE A*-C inc English and maths

GCSE 2013: % 5+ GCSE A*-C inc English and maths





KS4 2013: % pupils making expected progress from KS 2 - KS4





GCSE 2013: %5+ GCSE A*-C inc English and maths : FSM








Barnet GCSE 2013: % pupils making expected progress KS2-KS4: maths









KS1 - KS2 PROGRESS


KS2 ASSESSMENTS 2013: RWM L 4+
