<p>Description of the aspect</p>	<p>Improving Participation / Reducing Risk of NEET</p> <p>Preventing young people 14 plus from dropping out of Education and increasing young people's retention in EET or training until the age of 18.</p>
<p>Prevalence in Barnet / nationally</p>	
<p>How might this group be vulnerable?</p>	<p>Research shows there are clear NEET indicators and young people who become NEET are much more likely to remain long term unemployed throughout adulthood.</p>
<p>What is the impact / consequence of that vulnerability?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Low academic achievement and attainment • Lack of access to further educations • Poor future life chances • Possible undiagnosed learning difficulties • General lack of engagement
<p>Common signals of risk</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Low attendance • Low attainment • Lack of motivation • Low confidence and self esteem • Behaviour problems • Fixed term or Permanent exclusion • Lack of direction and future focus • Complex home and personal life. <p>Elaine may want to add RONI list</p>
<p>Who might notice?</p>	<p>School & college staff Youth services Other agencies/organisations already involved with the young person</p>
