- support schools in understanding the context for responding to incidents and manage the day-to-day issues that arise
- value PSHE/RSE as a curriculum platform to address sexual violence and building healthy relationships
- explore the Healthy Schools London Award programme as a whole school approach (**Health Education Partnership - Template Silver Action Plan**) to assist schools in managing sexual violence, child on child abuse and harassment.

This support provides: strategic leadership, continuum of help and support policy templates, guidance, Child-on-Child abuse audit form, newsletters and exclusion support [Safeguarding | Barnet Education & Learning Service \(bels.org.uk\)](#)
 - **Incident management-** There are structured procedures for managing incidents and emerging issues and each school response is led by a **Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL)**.
 - **Safeguarding Network** :The DSLs meet regularly as part of a safeguarding network.
 - **Pastoral and wellbeing support** (and staff networks associated with these roles) within the school also play a critical role in ensuring a “wrap around” support to manage safeguarding issues that arise within the school community.
 - **[Home : Operation Encompass](#)** Operation Encompass is a partnership between police and schools dealing with incidents of domestic abuse , a school can only join if the local police force has already joined Operation Encompass.
